



IMSH 2026 Registration Categories

General Session Registration includes daily Plenary sessions, accredited educational content, program materials, exhibit hall access, coffee breaks and three (3) lunches. Rates for SSH Members, Non-Members, U.S. Government, and Undergraduate Students.

One-Day Pass registration includes daily Plenary Session, accredited educational content, Exhibit Hall access, beverage breaks and lunch (when available). ***One-Day Pass registration does NOT include eligibility to register for any additional paid activities or content.*** One-day purchase is not allowed for Saturday, January 10. Purchase of more than (1) One-Day Pass is not allowed. See full conference program for detailed schedule and offerings for each day.

Guest Pass registration includes Plenary Sessions, Exhibit Hall, beverage breaks and lunches. Does NOT include access to the General Session courses, Pre/Post-conference Immersive Courses, or virtual content. General Session registrants may only purchase one (1) guest pass. Guest passes may only be purchased via the registration of a General Session attendee.

Not Attending IMSH

If you are ONLY attending an Accreditation, CHSE/CHSOS course, or the IMSH 2026 Technology Forum event, you do not have access to additional IMSH activities.

Only those with a full IMSH registration may attend other preconference events, the President's Diamond Ball, educational content, or other IMSH activities.

Join us for "*IMSH 2026 Technology Forum: Unleashing Potential - Removing Barriers to Technology Integration* – a can't-miss, two-day preconference event ahead of IMSH 2026

This two-day event is your opportunity to tackle the real-world challenges preventing effective technology adoption in simulation-based education. Through interactive dialogue and collaborative problem-solving, this forum will bring together simulationists (educators and operators), administration, and corporate partners to explore and overcome persistent obstacles to adopting advanced technologies in healthcare simulation. Through general and breakout sessions, participants will unpack barriers to use and implementation, such as cost, infrastructure, faculty readiness, and integration within existing systems.

SSH Accreditation Application Readiness Course

MORNING SESSION: This interactive 4-hour workshop guides participants through the SSH Accreditation process, focusing on the Core, Teaching/Education, and Human Simulation standards. Through presentations, hands-on activities, and peer discussions, attendees will gain practical tools and strategies to assess readiness, align educational practices, and prepare accreditation documentation. Designed for simulation leaders and educators, the session empowers programs to pursue and sustain accreditation with confidence.

AFTERNOON SESSION: This interactive 4-hour workshop prepares simulation professionals to pursue SSH accreditation in the specialty areas of Fellowship, Systems Integration, Research, and Assessment. Participants will explore accreditation standards, required documentation, and evidence strategies through practical sessions and collaborative activities. Designed for simulation leaders, researchers, and educators, this session empowers participants to evaluate their program's readiness, identify evidence gaps, and implement quality improvement strategies aligned with accreditation standards.

Attendees are NOT required to purchase IMSH General Session registration to be eligible for Accreditation Course registration. Learners will receive a maximum of 7.0 Interprofessional Continuing Education (IPCE) credits for attending the all-day course, or 4.0 IPCE credits for the half-day courses.
